TO TRANSFER THE OWNERSHIP OF A VEHICLE OR TRAILER

A vehicle can only be registered in the name of an incorporated body or person, who must be 17 years of age or over. The seller must complete this form and attach Registration Certificate and approval from any financial Institution (Bank etc.) The buyer must complete this form and submit to the LTA with a valid Third Party Insurance Policy and vehicle financing details (if any) together with his identity within 7 days of acquiring the vehicle. A transfer fee and all arrears must be paid to LTA by the new owner unless otherwise agreed between the buyer and seller of the vehicle before the transfer is processed. Until the transfer is processed by the LTA the vehicle remains in the seller's name and he/she may be liable for any traffic offences.

MOTOR VEHICLE DECLARED VALUE

The value to declare for a motor vehicle is calculated on either the purchase price or the market value whichever is applicable, including any improvements the applicant must declare. The value of the motor vehicle shall be the correct value as at the date the Application to Transfer Vehicle Registration form is signed.

The onus is on the person making the declaration to ensure that the vehicle stated is a true representation of the value of the motor vehicle. Where LTA feels the value is understated it will provide its own valuation at the owner's cost.
