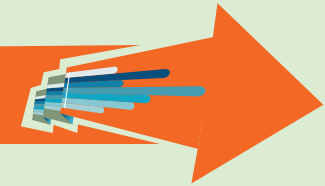
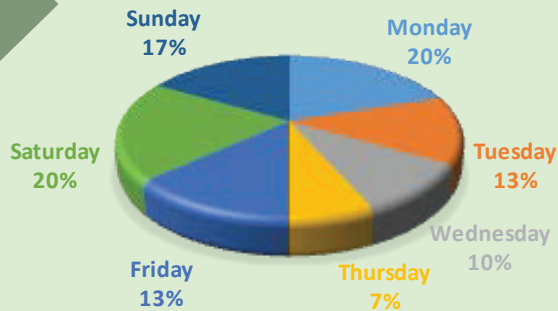


FACTSHEET 3: FATALITY FACTS – JANUARY 2017 TO JUNE 2017



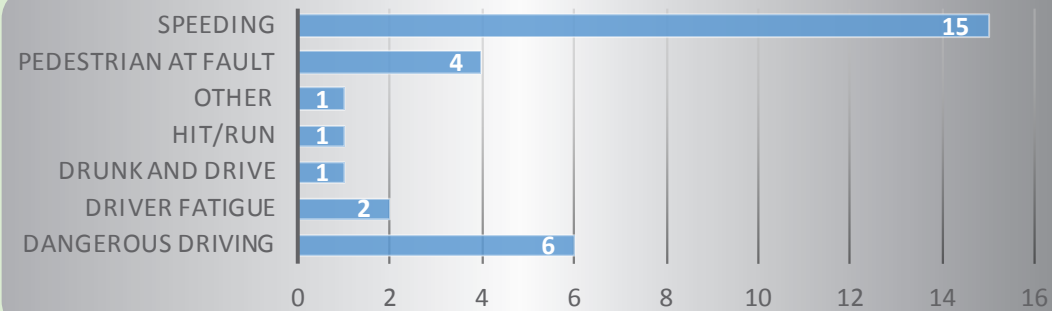
TOTAL RECORDED FATALITIES: 30 CENTRAL EASTERN (9), WESTERN (18), NORTHERN (3)

FATALITIES BY DAY OF THE WEEK

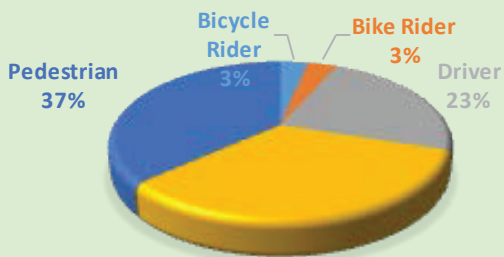


According to the fatalities statistics, a high number of fatalities are recorded during the weekends; Saturday (20%) and Monday (20%) being the highest followed by Sunday (17%).

FATALITY CAUSES

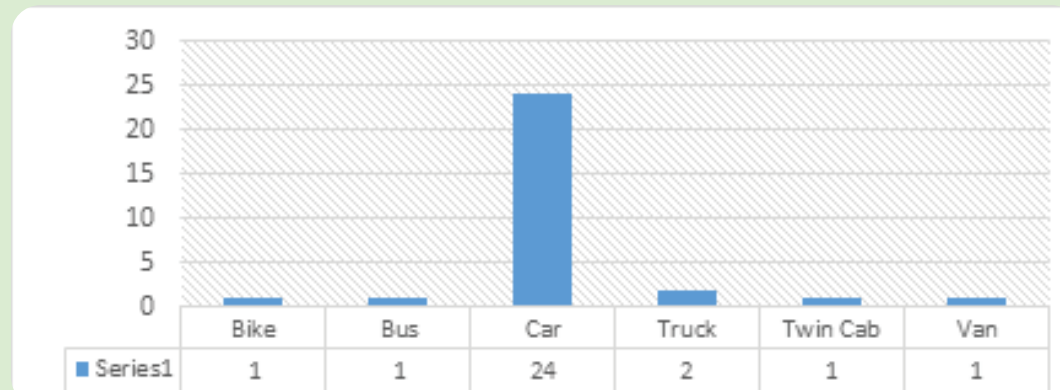


FATALITIES BY VICTIM TYPE



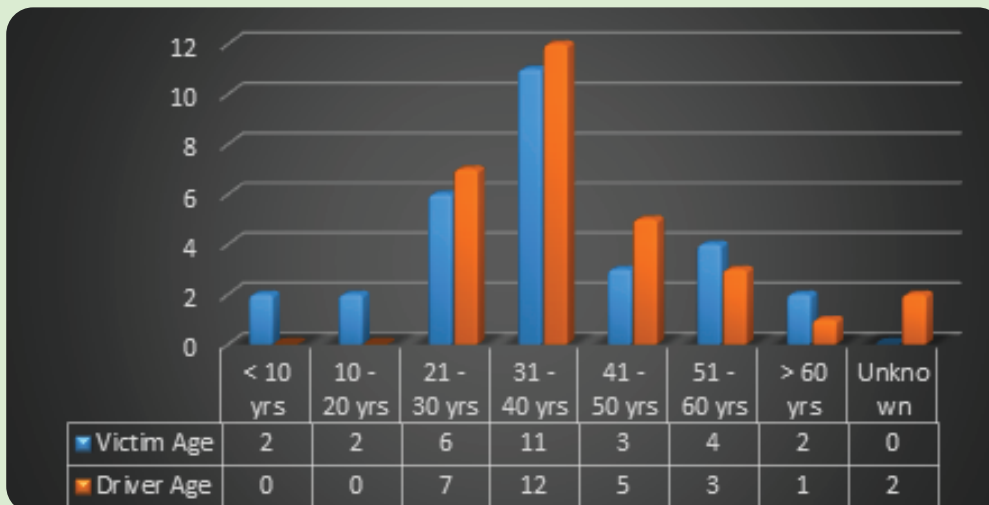
From this chart, it can be noted that majority of the fatality victims were pedestrians (37%) followed by passengers (34%) and drivers (23%).

VEHICLE TYPE



The above graph depicts that of all those vehicles involved in an accident/fatality, majority were cars (80%) followed by trucks (7%) and the other vehicle types at approximately 3% respectively.

DRIVER AND VICTIM AGE



The victim and driver age is analyzed into 10 year intervals. The fatality victims and drivers involved were both mainly aged between 31 – 40 years.

SUMMARY

- 80% of vehicles involved were Cars
- 50% of the fatalities occurred in the Weekends (Friday – Sunday)
- 37% of the victims were Pedestrians
- 50% of the fatalities were caused by Overspeeding
- Majority of the drivers (40%) and victims (36%) involved were aged between 31 – 40 years
